



We have now opened up our school age Summer Camp enrollment!

Please see the attached enrollment form and our activity planner! We bill Summer Camp monthly. Our Summer Camp will begin Monday, May 29th and last until the day before school begins in August (TPS has not release that day yet). We will offer one Vacation week between those time frames. Example of this would be someone who does not want to start summer camp until Monday June 5th, your vacation week would then be used for May 29th through the 2nd and you would not receive another vacation week for the duration of the summer. Please know that health and safety is of the utmost importance and we will continue to monitor COVID cases and safety protocol throughout the summer.

There is a \$200 Summer Camp enrollment/supply/field trip fee. This covers supplies needed, field trip costs, food costs, etc. This fee CONFIRMS and HOLDS your summer camp spot. Please know that your spot is only held when that \$200 Enrollment & Supply fee is paid and the enrollment packet is turned in!

Tuition includes breakfast, lunch, & snack, field trips, & more!

5 Days a week: \$1,150 per month (\$265 per week)

Operating Hours: 7:00 am - 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday and your tuition covers that entire day if needed!

Currently enrolled families get "Early Bird enrollment!" We will open our enrollment up to current families first to obtain your spot! Please know that spots fill QUICKLY and we will be opening up enrollment to outside inquires on Monday, March 6th. If you haven't enrolled by then, you can assume that enrollment will fill by the end of March! Enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis, so reserve your spot quickly if you are wanting your child to participate.

ALL Enrollment Packets are due by Monday, April 3rd so that we can start planning our numbers for field trips and order our shirts!

We are so excited for summer camp this year! We cannot wait to have an awesome summer filled with learning and fun! If you have any questions regarding what you see attached, please let me know!

Enrollment Agreement

	ollment Agreement is due upon enrollment, along with the Enrollment Form and Immunization Form. following, I am agreeing that I understand:
	I understand that tuition is \$1,150.00 for 5 days a week and my vacation week is worth \$265.00.
	Tuition is due on the 1 st of each month and considered late on the 5 th . Tuition can be paid via check, cash, Visa or Mastercard through automatic withdrawal. I understand that I have the auto draft option of all at the 1 st of the month, or half (\$575) on the 1 st of the month and the other half on the 15th of the month.
	My child's picture will be taken for classroom use and to post on our Facebook/Newsletter. No names will be posted publicly in conjunction with your child.
	I understand that in order to receive 1 vacation week, I have to submit my vacation slip at lest 2 weeks in advance. A credit of \$265 will then be added to your account. Please know that no refunds will be given for last minute vacation plans and your enrollment in our program is from May 29 th through the last day before school starts (Date TBD by TPS).
	I understand that by enrolling my school age child in our Summer Camp Program, we will not be responsible for any toilet accidents that occur. If your child has an accident at school and notifies us, we will call the parent or guardian to tend to the child. HCJK staff cannot not be responsible for tending to, cleaning up, or changing any school age children.
	I understand that behavior is of the utmost importance during Summer Camp. I understand that if my child is using profanity, being disrespectful towards staff or friends, aggressive, or exhibiting any serious behavior concerns, we will be sending that child home immediately and repeated occurrences could result in disenrollment from the program. Frequent disruptions in class, disrespect, or safety concerns <i>will</i> result in disenrollment.
	I understand that HCJK reserves the right to disenroll for any reason at any time.
	I understand that if I choose to pull my child for any other camps (Church camp, Girl Scout Camp, Horse Camp, Boy Scout Camp, TPS July Camp) I will be disenrolling unless tuition is paid in full. Any child leaving for TPS Camp in July will not be allowed to return in August unless tuition for July is paid in full.
	I understand that credits are not given for days missed due to illness and last-minute absence.
	My account must be up to date, with a zero balance, at the conclusion of Summer Camp to avoid any debt being sen to collections.
	I understand that HCJK is a nut free schools and any items brought from home must be nut free out of the respect for staff and children with nut allergies.
	If my child has food restrictions (allergies, vegetarian, vegan, or any other dietary needs) I understand that I must supplement his/her food each day by bringing a nut free meal, snack, or alternate milk (no almond milk) , so that my child has something to eat for their meal times during the school day.
	I understand that my child must be at HCJK before 10:00am each day and must be picked up no later than 6:00pm. SOME FIELD TRIPS MAY BE SCHEDULED TO LEAVE BEFORE 10AM; HCJK WILL COMMUNICATE THESE CHANGES WHEN NECESSARY.
	If my child misses the field trip bus, I understand that I will be responsible for their care that day and no tuition credit will be offered.
	I must pick up my child each day before the school closes – there is a \$1 per minute charge if my child is not picked up by 6:00pm – it must be paid in cash at the time of pick up.
	I have read and understand the sick policy located in the parent handbook (online – a hard copy can be provided to you upon request) and understand its contents.

Behavior Management Policy

Happy Campers Philosophy on Behavior Management: Discipline and guidance shall be consistent and based on an understanding of the individual needs and development of the child. We must have the parent's help and support in this matter. The staff shall direct discipline to the goal of maximizing the growth and development of the children and for protecting the group and individuals within it. The staff will interact with each child in a positive, respectful manner. Positive behavior will be praised. The discipline approach shall always be gentle, but firm. Redirecting the child to another activity shall always be the first method of discipline. Time out is used as a last resort. No child will be subjected to physical or psychological punishment.

If behavior issues with a student arise, staff will abide by the following policies:

- Discuss the concern with the student. Offer alternative suggestions to handling the student's feelings/negative behaviors (ex. breathing exercises, finding another activity, walking away from the situation/asking to take a break) and/or model correct behavior to the student.
- If negative behavior continues or behavior is severe, a written Behavior Report will be sent home to parents/guardian. Discuss the behavior with the parent and possible strategies that may be utilized to help the child succeed.

If a child receives TWO Behavior Reports sent home, the following steps will be taken:

- The parent/guardian of the child will be contacted to have a Parent Meeting with the Director and a Behavior Intervention Plan will be discussed. This plan could include shortening the length of time the child attends in a day, requiring immediate parent pickup upon negative behavior instances, etc. *NO TUITION DISCOUNT WILL BE GIVEN IF A CHILD IS REQUIRED TO SHORTEN THEIR DAY/TIME AT HC DUE TO BEHAVIOR CONCERNS.
- If the child continues to exhibit negative behaviors on a consistent basis/behavior is severe enough, the child may first be given a suspension from the program for up to 5 days at the discretion of the Director.
- If behavior continues, the child may be subject to permanent <u>disenrollment</u> from the program. Happy Campers reserves the right to disenroll any student at any time for any reason.

The following behaviors will result in disciplinary action:

- If the student is harming themselves.
- If the student is harming others (other students or staff).
- If the student is harming HC property.
- Student is using profanity or unkind language.
- If the student runs out of the classroom/off site/out of the sight of a staff member without permission.
- If the student is disruptive on the bus/refuses to board the bus.
- If the student's behavior is consistently disruptive to the program and affects all other students attending the program.
- If a parent or guardian verbally or physically abuses a staff member, another parent or another student.
- If a parent or guardian fails to abide by any HC policy/procedure or Behavior Plan.
