

# Potty Training Tips

- Communication, patience, and a positive attitude will all lead to a consistent potty-training plan for children
- You must have a few changes of clothes on site for accidents.
- We will put a child in a pull-up after two accidents in their clothing or underwear
- Children must be always in a pull up or in underwear/panties
- Our goal is to never stress a child out and work on a routine that leads to success for the child

# Items to Bring

Once we start this journey there will be some items we will need you to bring from home to help make this process successful.

- 2 to 3 changes of clothes (bottoms, tops, and underwear/panties)
- A wet bag or bag of some kind to store wet clothing
- Pull-Ups (the only permitted kind of pull ups are the brands that open on the side. Brands that do not open on the side and that just pull up require us to remove all of the child’s clothing to change them)
- A positive and patient attitude!



# Potty Training Twos & Older

At Happy Campers we believe that children are potty trained when they can leave a group of friends, find a teacher, and ask to go potty. Once your child is ready to start their potty-training journey, we ask that you begin the conversation at home and we will follow your lead here at the school. We fully believe that this process is a partnership between us at Happy Campers and the parents at home. We will only start this process in the two-year old class and do not start potty training children in the one-year old (Toddler) rooms.
